The Greensboro Elks Lodge has launched a local project to gather history from as many Veterans as possible. The project will host an Open House on the 4th Saturday of each month until further notice. Video-taping dates are listed below.

Veterans will be asked to provide information on a form that will be used for the interview. The interview, conducted by a trained veteran, will be video-taped and will take as long as the veteran being interviewed desires to share his or her information. The veteran will receive a copy of the interview. If requested, additional copies for family members will be provided.

The original copy of the interview will be sent to the Library of Congress where it will be archived based on the era in which the veteran served. It will then be available in the future for researchers and for family members that may come to research your memories, generations from now.
