

KIDDY POOL – There are no lifeguards for this pool. Parents are responsible for caring for their children, whether in or out of the water. No children over the age of 5 are allowed in this pool, this will be monitored by the Lifeguards. Babies must wear rubber pants to prevent accidents and closing of the pool for disinfecting (all pools).

LAP POOL (4' to 5' DEEP) – Adults swimming laps shall have the right of way at all times. If the pool is too crowded the lifeguards may ask that the pool be cleared for lap swimmers. A parent must supervise children under the age of 12. Non-swimmers are not allowed in this pool unless the parent is in the water with them. No beach balls, floatation devices, or snorkels are allowed, this includes float night.

MAIN POOL (SHALLOW END) –At the parent’s discretion, a non-swimmer may wear a Coast Guard approved, child-size life jacket or vest in the main pool (no floaties, tubes, snorkels, or rafts). **At any time, lifeguards may restrict excessive horseplay and ball throwing for the overall safety of our members.** Floats will only be allowed in the pool during designated Float Nights, which are Friday nights.

MAIN POOL (DEEP END)/DIVING BOARD – NO NON-SWIMMERS ALLOWED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at any time. All other waiting diving board users must wait on the pool deck, not the ladder. Diving on top of, or next to, someone is not allowed. The diving board may be closed during portions of the day for free swim in the Deep End, at the discretion of the lifeguard or manager on duty. Safety regulations prohibit any of the following actions off either diving boards: handstands, cartwheels, and/or seated dismounts. Parents may not wait under the diving board to catch their “non-swimmers.” Balls of any kind may not be thrown at someone jumping from the high dive.

GENERAL RULES -

- NO SWIMMERS under the age of 12 shall be left at the pool without parental supervision. A swimming test may be required. Any child between 12 and 16 must give an emergency name and phone number to the lifeguard at the gate.
- Veranda will be closed Friday nights and for any special events. Pool parties MAY NOT use the veranda. The veranda is considered part of the lodge and dining hall, THERE IS NO SMOKING ON THE VERANDA.
- Proper bathing attire is required. Swim shirts may be worn.
- The pool deck and game room is to remain free of debris and litter at all times.
- **The lifeguard staff members have the right to restrict swimming and/or enforce clean-up duty on any pool member or guest that does not abide by pool rules.**
- **NO RUNNING, PUSHING, OR UNSAFE BEHAVIOR ON THE POOL DECK, IN THE POOL, OR IN THE BUILDING WILL BE TOLERATED!**
- There is to be NO ACCESS to the upstairs lodge from the pool area by any member or guest at any time. Exceptions MAY occur when there are lodge approved events held in the upstairs lodge hall which are open to pool members.
- Soap showers are required by the Board of Health before entering the pool.
- NO WALL BALL.
- No Member or Guest is allowed in the pool without House Committee approval during pool closing hours.
- The upstairs bar is for adults only.
- **Non-members and children are not permitted access to the downstairs locker rooms. Any offender of this rule will receive an automatic two-week suspension of pool privileges.**
- **VIOLATION of these rules will result in a warning or revocation of pool privileges for repeat offenders.**

MEMBERSHIP – Elks in good standing may purchase an annual family, couple, or single membership to the pool. Two pool cards are issued for family membership and one card for individual membership. The cards are non-transferable and memberships are non-refundable. The pool card must be shown at the gate in order to gain admission to the pool. **If a lifeguard, and/or member of the House/Pool Committee suspect someone is using a pool card that is not theirs, picture identification will be required.**

GUESTS – A pool member MUST sign in guests and a guest fee of \$5 per person (excluding babies 3 and under) must be paid at the gate. Nonmember visitors are not allowed to remain within the pool area unless their inviting member is present. This includes childcare givers or nonmember family members. **FAILURE TO SIGN IN GUESTS COULD RESULT IN REVOCATION OF POOL PRIVILIGES AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HOUSE/POOL COMMITTEE.**

LINES - There are to be no lines for entry into the pool prior to 6am on any given day, including opening day and all holidays. Any vehicles and/or persons at the lodge prior to 6am are subject to a trespassing violation and possible vehicle towing. No drinking or drug use, there will be zero tolerance on this matter. The entire pool membership will be forfeited on the first offense.

COOLERS – Members and guests may bring coolers with snacks and beverages. No glass or alcoholic beverages are permitted. COOLERS WILL BE INSPECTED at the gate and are subject to random search during pool operating hours. **Anyone, including family and guests of a member, found with alcoholic beverages not purchased at one of the Elks lodge bars will be asked to leave the pool premises immediately and will forfeit their pool membership for the remainder of the pool season. This forfeiture will be NON-REFUNDABLE, includes access to the Tiki Bar, and will impact all those listed on the Pool Membership Card.**

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES/TOBACCO PRODUCTS/E-CIGARETTES – No one under the age of 21 may consume alcoholic beverages, and no one under the age of 18 shall smoke anywhere on the premises, including the parking lot. **No smoking on pool deck, this includes E-Cigarettes/Vapes.** Smoking is only allowed on the Tiki Deck and Pit Crew picnic areas.

Swimmer Zone - The painted Red-Line border creates unobstructed routes for the bartenders between the Tiki Bar and the Lodge building. **There is to be no eating, drinking, or smoking inside this boundary. There are to be no chairs, tables or other items inside this boundary.** If you attempt to sit between these lines, you will be asked to move. During rest period, no children are to be inside this boundary.

BIRTHDAY PARTIES – Birthday parties are allowed with prior consent and a signed contract **ONLY**. Parents are to pay a guest fee of \$5 per guest. A \$50 cleanup deposit is required at time of signing contract. Parents are responsible, however, for cleaning up after the party and leaving the area clean for other members. All decorations must be removed. Birthday parties must be held at the designated tables near the game room **ONLY**.

CHAIRS/TABLES – Seating is limited and therefore only one chair or chaise lounge is allowed per person. You may bring your own beach chair if you wish. Table, chairs, and chaise lounge chairs **MAY NOT BE SAVED OR RESERVED**. Chaise lounge chairs (including personal chairs) are **NOT** allowed on the Tiki Bar deck at any time or for any reason. The Lodge is not responsible for lost, stolen, moved or misplaced items. **VIOLATION** of these rules will result in a warning or revocation of pool privileges for repeat offenders.

TIKI BAR DECK – The Tiki Bar deck and the stairs leading to the deck itself are open to all Elk members, in good standing, and guests 21 and over during operating hours. No one under 21, including small children, are allowed on the Tiki Bar deck and/or stairs.

PARKING LOT - **There is to be no drinking or drug use of any kind in the parking lot. There is a zero tolerance policy regarding drinking and drugs use, pool memberships will be revoked on the first violation.** This includes waiting in line for the pool to open and will be enforced strongly. Please maintain an appropriate speed when driving through the Parking Lot, there are often times children running around.

NANNY PASSES - A "nanny pass" may be purchased for an additional \$125, in the Lodge Office. This pass will be a separate card, in an alternate color from the Pool Member cards. The pass is only valid for the "nanny" whose name appears on the card. There must be a copy of their **picture ID located in both the main office and the lifeguard shack** to prevent the use of the card by any other persons. The "nanny" may **not** be a member or belonging to the family of a member of Greensboro Elks Lodge #602. Should the use of the "nanny pass" be abused, the entire family's pool membership will be subject to suspension.

ADULT SWIM – No one under the age of 16 will be allowed in the pool during Adult Swim, with the exception of babies one year or younger who are accompanied/being held by an adult. All "adults" will be expected to exhibit mature behavior or will be asked to leave the pool at the discretion of the Lifeguards, and/or House and Pool Committee members.

As stated in the pool rules, if any member or guest is caught with alcohol in the pool area or attempting to bring alcohol into the pool that member's pool membership will be revoked for the remainder of the pool season. There is no appeal on the loss of membership due to violating ALE laws.

As always, members are responsible for their family and their guests. Should any of these rules be violated by the member or someone the member is responsible for, the entire membership is still subject to forfeiture. Please make sure your family and any guests you bring onto the premises are aware of these rules. The House Committee and/or the Pool Committee both have the right to eject a member, their family and/or their guests for any violations.
